# National Representation

Dear participants,

You are also encouraged to dress up in your national clothes during European Village Party & in the Twinning Fair. (Of course, you can also consider dressing up partially-such as having a traditional hair piece, bracelet, jacket etc.)

To keep up your delegations' spirit you may also consider delegation wears. (like tshirts or hoodies or bracelets).

During the opening ceremony, you may perform a short music performance if you are up to it. (If you are able to carry your instrument)

During session times, a wide range of clothing is welcomed. Our dress code statements are suggestions for you to Smart casual wear would fit the atmosphere of the GA the best, especially in the first days. Delegation wear, FMO clothes are also welcomed.

Dear Local Coordinators and National Coordinators,

To preserve the wellbeing of your members during European Village Party the EMSA European Board as well as the OC would like to ask you to oversee the implementation of the following suggestions. While they are not compulsory, they are

- Please ensure that over drinking is not encouraged in your countries

- Please do not only bring alcoholic beverages, EVP will also welcome non-alcoholic traditional beverages.
- Please guide your FMOs to also have food on the table.
- Please have *food with high lipid* content on your table as lipids slow down the absorption of alcohol and slow down the intoxication.
- Please do not bring home made spirits to the EVP
- Please submit 3 national songs in order of priority through the link provided in the email
